

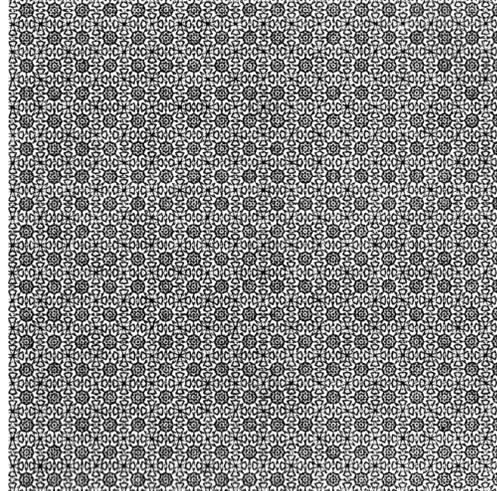
INSTRUCTIONS TO CANDIDATES
