

About 30 per cent of all readily available freshwater in the world is groundwater. Groundwater contains saline water. There are two types of groundwater- aquifers and well.

Surface water includes bodies of water such as lakes, rivers, ponds and streams. Rainfall is the natural supply of surface water. It contains salt water as well as fresh water. There are three types of surface water- perennial, ephemeral and man-made.
